Rubber Band Ligation of Hemorrhoids

Today your internal hemorrhoids have been treated by the application of a tight rubber band, cutting off the blood supply to the hemorrhoid. The hemorrhoid will shrivel up and fall off within a week.

You may have multiple hemorrhoids, and this may require multiple treatments over the next several months before all the hemorrhoids and symptoms are improved.

What to expect when you get home

- You may feel a dull ache for 36-48 hours following this treatment.
- You may feel pressure or like you need to have a bowel movement.
- You may experience some bleeding.
- When the hemorrhoid falls off, you may notice some bleeding and this is normal. If you are
 having several bloody bowel movements (more than 4 or more) over several hours, please call
 office immediately.

What to do for pain or discomfort

- If you are feeling discomfort, you may take Tylenol (as directed on the bottle).
- Taking a warm water Sitz bath or sitting in a tub of warm water for 15 minutes several times a day works best to relieve the discomfort.
- Using a heating pad on low temperature for 15 minutes at a time.
- You may use a numbing medication such as RectiCare or Calmoseptine ointment before and after bowel movements

Diet

- No special diet is necessary.
- Starting high fiber foods or using a fiber supplement (Metamucil) will help keep stools soft.
- Drink plenty of water, 6-8 glasses daily (if not on a fluid restriction).

Restrictions

• There are no restrictions. You may continue your normal activity.

When to call office

 Contact office immediately if having fever 101F, severe pain, unable to urinate, or heavy bleeding.
